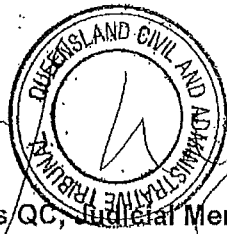


IT IS THE DECISION OF THE TRIBUNAL THAT:

1. The respondent is publicly reprimanded;
2. The respondent is suspended from practising as a legal practitioner for a period of three years;
3. The respondent's next application for a practising certificate must be accompanied by a copy of the reasons in this application, and the reports of two practising psychiatrists, who have been provided with a copy of those reasons and who have reported independently of each other, on the respondent's mental condition and its effect on his ability to engage in legal practice, the reports to be obtained within six months prior to the application; and
4. The respondent is to pay the applicant's costs of and incidental to the application to be assessed on the standard basis.
